Termination of Easement Application for Binding Lot Agreement

Most lots within the City of Palm Coast have a 5 ft. Utility Easement around the perimeter of the lot. Vacating the easements where lots join is required if a residential or accessory structure crosses or is within the side yard setback of the adjoining property line.

The following items need to be completed and submitted to the City of Palm Coast:

1. Building Permit Application submitted demonstrating structure to be built across lot line and within easements.
2. Binding Lot Agreement Number _____ or Binding Lot Agreement Application.
3. Current surveys or plat maps showing all existing structures and easements.
4. Copy of deeds.
5. Contact the following entities to obtain written approval to release the easement:
 - a. Florida Power and Light: Send written request and site plan to Florida Power and Light, Attention: Engineering to Lorenisabel.repollo@fpl.com to obtain "Release of Easement" letter to submit to the City. Questions contact Loren Isabel at (386) 586-6478.
 - b. AT&T: Send written request and site plan to AT&T Engineering Attn: Jacob Brooks at jb068s@att.com to obtain "Release of Easement" letter to submit to City. Questions contact Jacob Brooks at 386-843-0316.
 - c. Spectrum (Formerly Bright House): Send written request and site plan to Charter Engineering Attn: Paul.E.Liakos@Charter.com to obtain "Release of Easement" letter to submit to City. Questions contact Paul Liakos at 407-215-8838.
6. Sketch of easement to be terminated for exhibit with Binding Lot Termination of Easement document.
7. If approved, all approval forms must be recorded at the expense of the applicant prior to permit issuance.
